The Speaker



Robert Skidelsky is emeritus professor of political economy at Warwick University. His three-volume biography of John Maynard Keynes (1983, 1992, 2000) won five prizes and his book on the financial crisis – *Keynes: The Return of the Master* – was published in September 2010. He was made a member of the House of Lords in 1991, where he sits on the cross-benches; he was elected a Fellow of the British Academy in 1994. His 2012 book on *How Much is Enough? The Love of Money and the Case for the Good Life* was co-written with his son, Edward.

He is also the author of *Britain in the 20th Century: A Success?* (Vintage, 2014), editor of *The Essential Keynes* (Penguin Classics, 2015), and co-editor of *Who Runs the Economy?* (Palgrave, 2016) and *Austerity Vs Stimulus* (Palgrave, 2017). His latest book is *Money and Government*, published by Allen Lane.
